What is Blended Learning?

- Blended learning is a combination of:
 - Traditional whole group instruction
 - Independent learning using technology
 - Flexible learning environment
 - In/out of the classroom
 - Haiku LMS and Google Apps

Why use Blended Learning?

- Allows teachers better flexibility to meet with students
- Uses technology to improve collaboration, communication and creativity
- Provides students with more learning opportunities

Classroom Days Vary

- The number of independent learning days and whole group instruction days will depend upon the teacher, class, and activity.
 - Independent learning will be blended with small group and individualized instruction.

Attendance and Deadlines

- Attendance will be taken each hour for all students in blended classes.
- Students will be expected to meet deadlines.
- Blended learning addresses the same learning targets as traditional classes.
