The Student Assistance Team (SAT) is an intervention process that involves problem solving and the development of a plan that will allow students the opportunity for success.

The SAT explores possibilities and strategies that will best meet the educational needs of the students, and support teachers and parents.

Members of the SAT may include, but are not limited to: parents, guardians, caregivers, school staff, students, and other community members who can provide support.

The team gathers information which includes student’s strengths, concerns, modifications/interventions that have been tried or used prior to the SAT, and other pertinent history and information. The team then develops a plan of action for student success. This process may take up to 40 minutes to complete. *For additional information about the SAT process or to schedule a SAT meeting, please contact your child’s school guidance counselor.*

Parents, Guardians and Caregivers know their children better than anyone. Your participation broadens the problem solving base of information, can clarify questions of staff and sends a strong message to your child that we are all working together for his/her benefit.
