



Severe Weather Remote Learning Plan - Students

As we prepare for the upcoming winter season, we want to make you aware of the snow day procedures we have in place in the event of inclement weather.

When assessing weather conditions, our priority is the safety of our students, families, and staff. Our administrative team reviews weather conditions well in advance whenever possible and discusses road conditions and safety issues with a team of public works, weather, safety, and transportation experts. We continue to monitor changing weather conditions and make every effort to finalize decisions on weather-related school closures, delayed starts, or early releases in a way that gives families sufficient time to plan accordingly. Announcements about school closings will be made on the radio station WJJQ (92.5 FM), TV stations WSAW-7, WAOW-9, and WJFW-12, the school district website, and the Hatchet App.

If we exceed two snow days, and students cannot attend school in person due to inclement weather, students **may** be required to participate in a Remote Learning day. A summary of these plans is included below. Additional details will be shared if we exceed three snow days.

During the Day	Students have no expectations from school.	<p>Early Childhood - 4K - 5: Due to fewer required instructional hours, TES students will not have mandatory assignments during inclement weather cancellations. Teachers may share educational activities and indicate when they will be available to support students virtually or by phone.</p> <p>Grades 6 -12: Students are expected to log in to Canvas at 9:00 am to access activities provided by the teacher to support learning from home. Students may be expected to attend one or more virtual learning sessions during the day. In grades 6-12, teachers may hold office hours at specific times when they will be online to support student learning. If those hours are inaccessible, please email your teacher for additional support.</p>
