Reading Support (Current K – 2) 9:00 – 10:10

If you have been receiving support with a Reading Intervention teacher and have been recommended for continued support through Summer School, this is the course for you! This course is designed for students who have not quite reached grade level reading.

Reading Support (Current 3 – 5) 10:20 – 11:30

If you have been receiving support with a Reading Intervention teacher and have been recommended for continued support through Summer School, this is the course for you! This course is designed for students who have not quite reached grade level reading.

Math Support (Current K – 2) 10:20 – 11:30

If you have been receiving support with a Math Intervention teacher and have been recommended for continued support through Summer School, this is the course for you! This course is designed for students who have not quite reached grade level reading.

Math Support (Current 3-5) 9:00 – 10:10

If you have been receiving support with a Math Intervention teacher and have been recommended for continued support through Summer School, this is the course for you! This course is designed for students who have not quite reached grade level reading.

Math Support (K through 5) 12:30-1:35

If you have been receiving support with a Math Intervention teacher and have been recommended for continued support through Summer School, this is the course for you! This course is designed for students who have not quite reached grade level reading.

Getting Ready For 4K (incoming 4k students)

This course is designed for children who will be entering 4K in the fall. The course will emphasize language arts such as oral communication, listening, following directions, and printing. Children will also work on simple numbering concepts. Activities will include rhymes, singing, drawing, painting, coloring, and games. **All day 9:00-2:50**

Camp Kindergarten (Current 4K students & students starting Kindergarten in the fall) \$3.00

Come and join the fun as we explore nature while practicing skills in literacy, writing, math and science. We will share stories, songs, crafts, snacks, and projects, all centered around camping in the Northwoods. **All day 9:00-2:50**

First Aid for Children Today (FACTS) (Current K-current grade 3)

This is an American Red Cross program to help children ages five to eight understand the important role they have in managing their own health and safety as well as the health of the environment in which they live.

- Introduce an awareness of behaviors and action that could lead to injuries or illness
- provide children with ways to prevent injuries
- provide children with first aid skills to respond to injuries
- encourage children to make choices that influence their health and environment in a positive way **Class time 9:00-10:10**

Disney Arts & Crafts (Current K through 3rd grade) \$3.00

Which Disney movie is your favorite? In this class we will watch a variety of Disney movies and do arts and crafts every day that go along with them! **Class time 9:00-10:10**

Innovative Design-Bridge Building (Current 4th gr. through 8th gr.)

STEM based class, students will receive hands on experience with the real world situation of planning, designing, budgeting, construction and demolition of the bridge building process. Students will work collaborate in small groups to use their imaginations to learn, explore and create their own bridge building. This course is designed for students in current 4th through 8th grade. **Class time 9:00-10:10**

Storytime Crafts (Current K through 3rd grade)

Bring your love of reading books and crafts together with Storytime Crafts! In this class we will read from children's classic books and then create a craft that is based on the book! We will read stories from authors Eric Carle, Leo Lionni, Lois Ehlert and many more. We will then tap into our creative minds by making crafts using paint, glitter, yarn, construction paper and many more items. **Class times 9:00-10:10 or 10:20-11:30**

Pop, Glop, and Fizz" 2 class times – See Below Fee \$3.00

Squishy, slimy, and bubbly are a couple of words to describe this class. Come explore the world of science through hands on activities that go "pop, glop, and fizz." We will be using math and literacy to help us read the recipes for the activities and to help us measure out ingredients. **Current 3rd and up 9:00-10:10 or Current K, 1, 2,3 10:20-11:30**

Nature, Scavenger, Exploring (Current 2nd grade & up)

A fun outdoors oriented class for students that want to learn more about area plants and animals and improve their research and discussion abilities. Class will involve nature hikes to discover local wildlife, research and learn more about what was discovered, discussions about the wildlife, and lessons about ways to have a healthy environment. Please make sure students have sun screen and bug spray daily. **Class time 9:00-11:30**



This class will focus on three popular outdoor activities: **kayaking, trail biking, and geocaching**. Each day we will explore new parts of our town and the natural world that surrounds us. No experience for kayaking is needed but you do need to be comfortable with the water and have **completed at least the first two levels of swim class**. **Older and younger students are both welcome but please make sure that you are able to bike and/or walk at least 4 miles per class period. This class is best suited for students in 3rd grade and up** but if you feel that your younger child would enjoy the class please discuss it with one of the two instructors to make sure they have an enjoyable experience. **You will need to have a bike and helmet that are in good condition. A good pair of tennis shoes is a must!!!** All other supplies and materials will be provided. Come along for this fun filled class of biking (pedaling), kayaking (paddling), and Geocaching (treasure hunting with a technology twist). Some items we will work on are balance while moving, balance with control on a variety of objects, cooperating with all class members and sharing equipment, participating in team building activities, following rules respectfully and choosing to participate in moderate to vigorous physical activity.

Class times 9:00-11:30 & 12:30-2:50

Innovative Design-Animation (Current 4th gr. through 8th gr.)

Using a STEM based approach, students will receive hands-on experience with animation creation. They will learn, explore, and create stop motion animation, and then use that knowledge and their own creativity to create their own animation. This course is designed for students in 4th through 8th grade only. Students will work collaboratively in small groups, but then have the option to design and create an animation of their own as a group or as an individual. **Class time 10:20-11:30**

Pets Mania: (Current K -3rd grade)

Come learn about all things cute and cuddly with us! We'll study all kinds of pets from dogs and cats to turtles and lizards through fun reading and writing activities.
