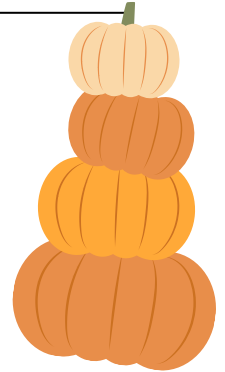

The process of locating, identifying, and evaluating children with disabilities is known as Child Find. The Tomahawk School District will conduct developmental screening for preschool children at least one time per academic year as scheduled above.

- 1.) Your student's immunization status or waiver status at school is up to date before **Oct 13th**. If you are unsure, please give me a call. Changes in requirements happen in 12th, 7th and Kindergarten.
- 2.) To update any health plans that are still active for your student (a new one is required each school year)
- 3.) Any prescription medications your student will take at school has a Parent and Provider Medication Consent form with it (medication cannot be given without this form)
- 4.) Your student has an over the counter medication form on file at school. Let us know if you need one sent home.

We are excited to introduce you to The Zones Regulation, a curriculum to support your learner's social and emotional development and regulation skills! The Zones of Regulation provides a simple way for learners (and the adults who support them) to understand, communicate around, and care for their feelings. Through The Zones of Regulation, we will explore feelings and build emotional awareness, recognize body signals related to our feelings, identify situations and triggers that impact our feelings, explore a variety of regulation tools and pause to problem solve before acting on our impulses. Together, we will practice regulating feelings and behavior in real-time and reflecting on if our regulation is working well for us.

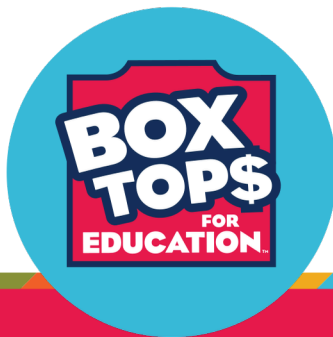

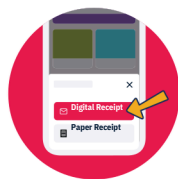

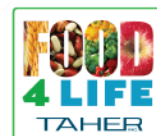
