Nurse Trina's Newsletter

Hello all,

This will be my last newsletter post for the year so please be sure to take a look at the reminders at the bottom of this section. I realize this is a lengthy update so bear with me...

The Lincoln County Health Dept is again offering their Vaccine for Children Program. The program provides low cost or free vaccines to eligible children in our area in hopes of decreasing barriers to vaccine and disease prevention programs. The informational flyers and dates are listed below.



End of year reminders:

~If your student has any health condition changes throughout the year, please be sure to update me in the health office and/or the building offices. Doing so ensures that records are up to date in case something should happen at school. This will also allow me to collaborate with parents/guardians to discuss any accommodation or attendance excuses if needed.

~Medications should be picked up at the end of the school year by parents. I know this seems early but it is something you will want to plan for as I will be out of the building at the end of the year for additional reminders. Medications that are not picked up with either be mailed home or destroyed.

~Incoming 7th grade students (for the 24/25 school year) who have not received their TDAP vaccine will be due for this prior to the 24/25 school year. Please plan ahead with your students' primary care provider. *You will find the vaccine requirements and completion form attached and on the Tomahawk School District Website under Health Services. Please note if you are choosing to medically waive a vaccine on the record form, you will need a provider signature. Please plan to have your child's vaccines updated by the 30th day of the upcoming school year.

~Over summer be on the lookout for any health paperwork that may be mailed home (health plans that need updating). Plans are sent home in summer so there is ample time to have them reviewed by your student provider if necessary. Health plans that are still in effect for students must be updated annually. All medical paperwork (including paperwork for medication administration at school) can be found here:

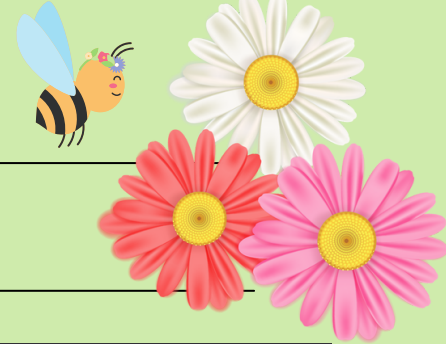
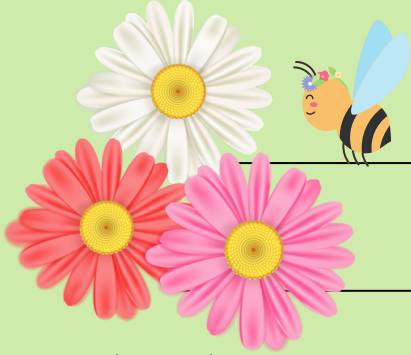

Vaccines for Children

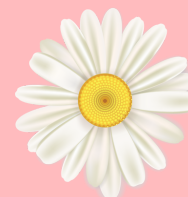

• Assertiveness. These lessons will give students a chance to practice asking an adult for help, telling an adult about an unsafe situation, and being assertive to get out of unsafe situations.
